

APPENDIX B to COR-2024-007

BY-LAW NUMBER 24-XXX

OF THE

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KITCHENER

Being a By-Law to Provide for the Appointment of a Person in the office of a member of council representing Ward 10

WHEREAS section 263 (1) (a) the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended (the Act) allows a council to fill a vacancy in the office of a member of council by appointing a person who has consented to accept the office if appointed;

AND WHEREAS a vacancy was declared in the office of a member of council representing Ward 10 in the City of Kitchener on December 14, 2023;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kitchener enacts as follows:

1. That the vacancy in the office of a member of council representing Ward 10 be filled by appointing a person who has consented to accept the office if appointed.
2. That the vacancy must be filled by someone who is eligible under the the Act to hold office provided, they:
 - a) reside in the local municipality or is the owner or tenant of land there or the spouse of such owner or tenant;
 - b) are a Canadian citizen;
 - c) are at least 18 years old; and
 - d) are not prohibited under subsection (3) of the *Municipal Elections Act*, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched or otherwise by law.

3. That _____, who has signified in writing that they are legally qualified to hold office and has consented to accept the office, is hereby appointed to the position of a member of council representing Ward 10 for the City of Kitchener, for the duration of the 2022-2026 term of Council.

4. This by-law will come into effect on the date of passing.
