Methods to Fill Vacancy for Office of Councillor, Ward 10

Background and Legislation

- Council declared a vacancy for Office of Councillor, Ward 10 on December 14, 2023.
- The Municipal Act, 2001 (Act) and Municipal Elections Act (MEA) require Council within **60 days** of declaring a vacancy to determine which method they will select to fill the vacancy.
- The Act requires Council to select one of two options to fill the vacancy:
 - By appointment; or
 - By calling for a By-election



Options to Fill Vacancy – Appointment

 If Council wishes to fill the vacancy by an Appointment process, Council shall select the method to ensure the process is completed within 60 days of declaring the vacancy. Council is required to consider one the following three appointment methods:

Option 1A

Appointment of a Ward 10 Candidate from the 2022 Municipal Election

Option 1B

Appointment through an established formal selection process

Option 1C

Appointment without a formal selection process



Options to Fill Vacancy – Option 1A – Appointment of 2022 Municipal Election Candidate

Requirements

- Written declaration of qualifications and consent to office (part of Appendix B)
- Appointment By-law (Appendix C) with candidate name populated considered at a public meeting

Timing

Candidate sworn into office by the end of January 2024

Costs

None



Options to Fill Vacancy – Option 1B – Call for Applications

Requirements

- Application Form and Adoption of the Appointment Procedures for Filling a Council Vacancy (Appendix B) approved
- Written declaration of qualifications confirmed (part of Appendix B)

Timing

- Application period January 9 to 25, 2024
- Applications considered by Council January 29, 2024 at a public meeting
- Candidate sworn into office by the end of February 2024

Costs

Approximately \$2,500 for advertising



Options to Fill Vacancy – Option 1C – Direct Appointment

Requirements

- Written declaration of qualifications confirmed (part of Appendix B)
- Appointment By-law (Appendix C) with candidate name populated considered at a public meeting

Timing

Candidate sworn into office by the end of January 2024

Costs

None



Options to Fill Vacancy – Option 2 – Ward Byelection

Requirements

- Adoption of by-election by-law (Appendix D) and implementation of Municipal Elections Act
- Amendments to the 2024 Committee and Council Meeting Schedule

Timing

- January 15 to February 23, 2024 Nomination Period
- April 4-6, 2024 Advance Voting Day
- April 8, 2024 Voting Day
- April 10, 2024 Official Results
- Candidate sworn into office by the end of April 2024

Costs

Approximately \$77,000 to \$100,000



Next Steps

- Council is required to determine which Option they wish to proceed with to fill the vacancy of Office of Ward 10, Councillor.
- Following direction from Council, staff will proceed with the planning for the option selected.
