- Communitech Open House May 28 Join us for tours and food trucks!






Event stats by quarter - FY24

Talent Attraction and Retention

Local companies are growing

- Helped local tech companies hire 750+ full-time and 700+ part-time employees.
- Operated workintech.ca, the largest tech job board in Canada
- Maintained thehelplist.ca, a crowdsourced list of tech industry professionals looking for employment, helping 1,000 individuals find new opportunities.
- Increased active Peer2Peer Groups to 15 with 580+ participants gathering in-person to learn collaboratively.



Startup & Scale-up Services

FY2024

- Direct interactions with 550+ companies of all sizes and stages of growth (startups, scaleups and enterprise)
- Onboarded 325 new startups
- Provided 5,631 mentor hours to spent helping client companies
- Launched ElevateIP programming, providing intellectual property support and funding to more than 490 companies



The Fierce Founders programs support women and nonbinary founders at all stages of growth

- Establish a robust business strategy including: sales, marketing, financials, IP etc.
- Develop investor relationships and gain access to capital
- Build a strong community of women and nonbinary founders
- FY2024: More than 30 founders in Intensive Track and Bootcamp
- Last cohort: Multiple companies surpassed \$1M in revenue, closed seed rounds
- 312 Fierce Founders since 2014



Our proposal



Supercharging the startup pipeline

Targeting 450 new startups per year by 2028

- Rebooting cohort-based startup programming with emphasis on in-person interaction at the Communitech Hub.
- Increasing the level early-stage tech startups from 325 in 2023 to 450 per year in 2028.
- Create and execute a combination of community outreach and a series of discovery and validation stage programs for early-stage tech startups.



Fierce Founders

Supporting 30+ female-identifying and underrepresented founders

Fierce Founders Bootcamp - 10 - 15 companies per year

- Supports the growth of early-stage companies by helping founders think bigger about their markets and validate their ideas
- Focused on pre-validation stage founders, helping them refine their ideas and identify potential markets



Fierce Founders - *continued*

Fierce Founders Uplift - 10 companies per year - \$10K in non-matched funding

- Hands-on support from Communitech's experienced growth coaches to help founders build and execute on a customized growth plan
- Assistance identifying market opportunities and uncovering the gaps within their go-to-market strategy.

Fierce Founders Intensive Track - 10 companies per year

- Targeted support for high-potential founders
- Focused on finding product market fit, growing sales and getting investment
- \$50,000 in matching funds for qualifying companies (via FedDev funding)



City of Kitchener investment for matching

Support from three levels for maximum impact

- Public funding allows Communitech to try innovative programming, such as Fierce Founders Uplift
- Matched funding encourages investment for feds and province by having two parties invest funds, sharing project cost
- The City's investment allows us to provide up to \$10K grants to 10 founders in our Fierce Founders Uplift program which unlocks \$100K in matched funding for the Fierce Founders Intensive Track program
- Stacking limits: Cannot match funds from same level of government
