# Background

- Operation Model Modernization efforts: 15 recommendations approved in June 2023.
- Current Status: 8 recommendations competed; 4 in progress; 3 not scheduled to start yet
- Complex Neighbourhood Associations: A need for tailored support for large, complex NAs.
- SPCA selection: Ideal pilot candidate due to scale and complexity of their operations.





### Agreement Development

- Collaboration: SPCA and City Staff worked together
- Third Party Facilitator: Not needed
- Key Items Addressed: Scope of activities of NA and City, facility use
- Detailed Clarity: Roles and Responsibilities; cooperation framework, and support mechinisms





## Primary Objectives

- Community Engagement: Encourage local participation
- Program Diversity: Ensure a variety of programs
- Inclusivity and Accessibility: Support for all community members
- Capacity Building: Foster local leadership and community strength





### Implementation and Evaluation

- Initial Term: Three years
- Annual Review: Evaluation meetings with SPCA
- Effectiveness Assessment: Joint review by City and SPCA
- Future Considerations: Potential expansion to other NAs after evaluation
