

## Subway Style Map

- Used mainly at start/end of route or major intersections
- Provides overview of route and highlights major destinations
- Final destination is at the top. People travelling in the opposite direction would see Boardwalk at the top.
- Level 1 and 2 destinations included on the sign

### Sign with no branding (existing)








### **Directional Blade**

- Used at intersections to help navigate route on trails
- Often used if there is not enough space for wingblade

# Sign with no branding (existing)







#### Wingblade

- Requires less space than a directional blade sign
