Quad Gym Proposal

- 33,800 sq. foot gym that would include:
 - 4 multipurpose courts to support fast growing sports like pickleball, basketball, volleyball, badminton
 - 40 ft ceilings and competition level flooring for provincial and national tournaments
 - Elevated mezzanine viewing gallery
- Gym would be physically connected to Kitchener Indoor Recreation Complex (KIRC) – takes advantage of shared spaces (e.g. change rooms, concessions)
- Future tournament destination direct revenue to the city, plus broader economic impacts for the community.




Opportunity: Build Gym with KIRC

- Building gym now means it would <u>cost less</u> and <u>open sooner</u>:
 - Cost of building gym now = \$29.9M
 - Timeline gym would open in 2026
- Building the gym on its own (after KIRC) would cost more and take longer:
 - Cost would increase to \$38M (30% increase) in 2026
 - Gym would likely not open for another 5+ years after 2026



KIRC Main Entrance – with Gym Attached








Gym – From KIRC Lobby

Project Budget / Funding Plan

- Project cost (if built with KIRC) = \$29.9M
- Potential funding sources:
 - \$10M Community Sport and Recreation Infrastructure Fund (Provincial)
 - \$10M Green and Inclusive Community Buildings Grant (Federal)
 - \$10M City contribution (debt financed)
- Without Provincial <u>OR</u> Federal funding, the City would have to fund the additional cost to a total of \$20M.
- Without Provincial AND Federal funding the gym project would not proceed,

• Meeting the following milestones would allow for the gym to be built at the same time as the KIRC:

Secure Provincial and Federal government decisions on grant applications	End of 2024
Gym construction begins	April 2025
Gym opens	Summer 2026
