No – ESR and geotechnical studies were necessary for the watermain and sanitary trunk sewer

There are two parallel projects in the Biehn Dr. Extension:

- Road extension
- Municipal services extension

Environmental Study Report states that the “watermain and sanitary trunk sewer [components]... are being completed as a Schedule B project”
