Landlords of affordable housing must be encouraged to uphold tenants' rights and maintain existing dwellings. Infrastructure grants ought to be looked into as a better solution to saving the dwindling number of affordable apartments in Kitchener, rather than demolition and more unaffordable apartments.
The stress and insecurity experienced by tenants is high and unhealthy, physically and mentally.
This is one area where the city of Kitchener can provide added protection for vulnerable residents.
