Thank you for the opportunity to provide a submission regarding the proposed development at 670 King Street West. My name is Ismail Ozturk, and I am a resident of Louisa Street.

I would like to begin by stating my support for the development and improvement of this parcel of land. I am pleased to see investment in our neighbourhood. While I support the project in principle, I have a few comments for the Committee's consideration. I trust the Committee will make a fair and balanced decision that considers the interests of all stakeholders.

## Recommendations for Consideration

My recommendations are as follows:

- 1. Preservation of the Tree Canopy on Louisa Street: I ask the Committee to ensure that sufficient municipally-owned land is retained along Louisa Street to either protect the existing mature trees or to accommodate the planting of new ones post-construction. A healthy tree canopy is vital to the character of our residential street.
- 2. Vehicular Access Point: To minimize traffic impact on the residential portion of our neighbourhood, I request that the primary vehicular access to the new building be located exclusively on the King Street side of the property.
- 3. Building Façade and Materials: I encourage a design that incorporates red brick for the façade of the first two floors. This design choice would create a pleasing aesthetic and a smooth transition from the commercial corridor of King Street to the adjacent residential areas. The nearby Station Park development is an excellent example of how this can be executed
