### Historic/Associative Value:

- Direct associations with educational development in Kitchener
- Ties to neighbouring church property

### Contextual Value:

- Supports the predominantly low-rise established neighbourhood
- Historically and visually linked to its surroundings
- Ties to adjacent St. John's Church – constructed around the same time and have served the same communities since construction
