The only issue remaining that flags is the direction of the numbering being proposed. I think, based on the established practise and the attached Planning policy, the numbering should be reversed. The numbering on Tartan begins on the east and increases going west, normally we would see the numbering of side streets follow that same flow, from the street origin increasing away from the origin point.

I will leave it to Planning to decide if the current layout meets their policy intent, as there are other developments nearby, that do not all appear to follow this policy. Personally, I would like to see the policy applied consistently for ease of wayfinding in an emergency, but if it has been waived in the past, no issue on my end.
